Growing up in a military family, Randy moved frequently and often had to leave friends behind. As he grew older and had a hard time finding and getting back in touch with people from his past, he came up with the idea for Classmates.com and launched the site from his basement in 1995.

By September 2004, Classmates had more than 38 million registered members, with 1.4 million paying for added benefits. Before the year was out, Classmates was acquired by United Online, a California-based Internet service company that also owned Juno, NetZero, and BlueLight.com.

Classmates.com now has more than 50 million members in the U.S. and Canada who are connected on the site with friends and acquaintances from school, work, and the military.
